


Large Item Trash Collection Zones for Madison County District 4

Improving services to the communities of Monrovia, Harvest and Toney

Our District 4 large item trash collection policy enables citizens every month to place debris at curbside for pickup, equal to the amount that will fit into a standard pickup truck bed.

Based upon the weight of that debris, the Huntsville Landfill charges District 4 a disposal fee. Because of these charges, we ask that you stay within the standard pickup truck amount limitations.

If your trash exceeds this amount, please call our office at 256-852-8351 to make arrangements. A special service charge of \$50 plus amount for manpower and disposal fees will be accessed.

We are attempting to be responsible with your tax dollars while providing a community service. All residents are charged \$2 a month for large trash collection. Thank you for your assistance.

Place these items at side of the road:

Limbs that fall from trees, grass clippings and leaves if bagged, couches, chairs and appliances.

Crews can not pick up:

- Tires, automotive products, car batteries, pesticides, household batteries, paint and related products.

Please call 256-880-6054, the Handle With Care Collection Center for disposal.

- Construction materials such as shingles, insulation, concrete block, bricks, rocks, cement and like materials. Contractors must remove construction debris.

- Stumps and dirt. These items and construction debris may be taken to the Huntsville Landfill at 256-881-8700.

- Pruned or cut trees unless you make special arrangements.
