DISTRICT 2

Beginning at a point that is the intersection of the west boundary of Madison County and U.S. Highway 72 West; thence south along the west boundary of Madison County, to its intersection with the Tennessee River; thence generally east following the Tennessee River to its intersection with the boundary of Redstone Arsenal; thence north along the boundary of Redstone Arsenal to its intersection with Census Block 1482, Tract 111; thence northeast and northwest along the boundary of said Census Block to its intersection with the boundary of Redstone Arsenal; thence north along the boundary of Redstone Arsenal to its intersection with Census Block 1466, Tract 111; thence along the west boundary of said Census Block to its intersection with the boundary of Redstone Arsenal; thence north along the boundary of Redstone Arsenal to its intersection with Zierdt Road; thence north along Zierdt Road to its intersection with Interstate I-565; thence east along Interstate I-565 to its intersection with Bob Wallace Avenue; thence east along Bob Wallace Avenue to its intersection with Jordan Lane; thence north along Jordan Lane to its intersection with Holmes Avenue; thence west along Holmes Avenue to its intersection with Sparkman Drive; thence north along Sparkman Drive to its intersection with University Drive, also known as U.S. Highway 72 West; thence west along University Drive to its Intersection with Hughes Road, a point also along the 2011 Madison City Limits; thence north, northwest, south, west, and south along the 2011 Madison City Limits to its intersection with U.S. Highway 72 West; thence west along U.S. Highway 72 West to the west boundary of Madison County, said point also being the point of beginning.
